#### YOU PUT ASIDE THE COMMANDMENT OF GOD TO CLING TO HUMAN TRADITIONS

We have come to the Twenty-Second Sunday in Ordinary Time in Year B and have resumed taking the Gospel passages from the Gospel of Mark after the five week period of the Gospels coming from chapter 6 of John's Gospel. In the Gospel passage we hear this weekend, Jesus is challenged by the religious leaders of the day and in his response we get to the heart of what it means to truly follow the commandment of God.

The disciples of Jesus were not following the Jewish traditions around washing of hands and food preparation and the Pharisees objected. But Jesus responds that nothing external makes a person unclean, it is what comes from a person, from their heart that makes a person unclean.

There is a strong temptation, and I certainly know that I do, to following rules. Rule following makes things easy. The road rules for example are pretty black and white—I can know when I am obeying the rules and when I am not—there is not too much ambiguity. The issue however is that when we think about God, then God's rules are not about minimums but are invitations to generosity and largeness, if you will. When we consider justice, mercy, compassion and above all love, then there is no limit, there is no minimum standard that we can meet and satisfy the commandment.

Jesus' issue with the religious leaders of his day, was that they tended to focus on the external rules and not try and practice or be open to a conversion of heart.


Jesus challenges us to know that we have to be open to the transforming power of the Holy Spirit to change our hearts. For when we are tempted to be selfish or self-serving then the invitation to take up our cross and serve leads us to a change of heart. And the remarkable thing is that as we respond to the Holy Spirit in our lives and grow in our capacity to be loving, merciful, compassionate or just then we can recognize that true happiness comes not from looking after ourselves but in serving others. It might be 'easier' to follow the rules but real or true freedom comes from a true conversion of heart.
