Our Annual Bereavement Mass

On this occasion people are encouraged to bring along a flower (please note one flower) to be used in the procession.

As is our custom, at this Mass we will have the blessing of our deceased family members exemplified through the crosses we have placed on the wall of the Church. We encourage parishioners to make their own "Cross" to be placed on the wall of the church.

[This cross should not be bigger than 6.5 cm across, 10 cm from top to bottom, 1.5 cm writing area]

After the Mass there will be a supper.

We encourage parishioners to bring along something for the supper; we also ask for volunteers to help organize and coordinate the supper. This supper has proved to be very important over the past few years, and is a wonderful opportunity for us to support each other by our presence.

The law of love

The readings this Sunday speak to us about the commandments. In the book of Deuteronomy and the Gospel of Mark we have the explanation of the commandments. We are given an understanding on how to live out God's commandments in our lives.

In the book of Deuteronomy and the Gospel of Mark, we find the theme of total submitting to love the God. To love God with all our hearts, with all our souls, with all our minds and strength means giving our whole being to God. All our talents and skills must be put into positive use to glorify God. It means all the gifts God has given us must be put into action.

Regarding the love of the neighbour, it demonstrates God's love. When we extend love to our neighbours we are living out and expressing God's love to humanity. Loving our neighbours means we are participating fully in God's love and mission and continue God's loving presence in our world.

As we reflect on the message of the readings provided, we are invited to reflect on our own faith journey as individuals. How do I live out these two commandments in my daily life? Do I submit myself totally to love God and neighbours with all God has given me so God's name can be glorified, and my neighbours can benefit from what God has given me? The law of God is what binds us together as children of God. If we live it out, our world will truly experience peace and harmony.
