# You are my Son, the Beloved

A psychotherapist friend once confided in me that many people undergo a loss of identity or an identity crisis. Most of these individuals identify themselves with their work, property, or reputation. Once these are gone, they no longer know who they are. One thing that may help is developing a consciousness of who we truly are.

On this Feast of the Baptism of the Lord, the last day of Christmas, we are given a solid anchor for our inner selves. Luke's Gospel recounts that as Jesus emerged from the water after His baptism, a voice was heard from heaven: "You are my Son, the Beloved; my favor rests on you" (cf. Luke 3:21-22). Jesus had a clear identity. He is the Son of God. He is the Beloved. God's favor rests on Him. Jesus did not create that identity; it is simply who He is. He approached His mission with that identity.

At our own baptism, we share that common identity with Jesus: we are God's children, loved by Him, and in relationship with Him. This identity is freely given to us. As St. Paul tells Titus, "It is not because of any righteous deeds we had done, but according to His mercy" (Titus 3:4-7).

Now, with the beginning of Ordinary Time—after receiving the infant Jesus in the manger—we are called to step out into the world, following behind the adult Jesus and embracing His mission. For some, it means the holiday is over; it's back to work, studies, and the usual routines of life. We will soon wrestle again with the ordinaries of life and the demands of daily living. But we can live differently, being more conscious that we are children of the Father, beloved by God, and favored by the Almighty. Perhaps then, the ordinary will not be ordinary at all.
