Christ is the Light of the World

This Fourth Sunday of Ordinary Time coincides with the Church's celebration of the Feast of the Presentation of the Lord. On this day, Jesus, as a child, was brought to the temple to be presented to God, in accordance with the Jewish custom for every firstborn son. This event highlights how Jesus' family obeyed the Jewish law, which required a sacrifice when a child was consecrated to the Lord.

His appearance in the temple was not only a demonstration of His obedience to the law—as one who chose to submit Himself under the law—but also a fulfillment of God's promise to send a Savior. This truth was recognized by two faithful servants, Simeon and Anna, who had long awaited the salvation of their people. Simeon, upon holding the child, exulted in God's faithfulness to him. Anna, the prophetess, after witnessing the event, gave thanks to God and shared the news with all who were waiting for redemption.

On this day, candles are often blessed to symbolize Christ, the Light of the World, shining in the darkness. At times, our lives may seem dark and monotonous, as if trapped in a cycle of repetition and human burdens. We can grow impatient, losing creativity and enthusiasm for what lies ahead. Yet, Simeon and Anna teach us an important lesson: as we age and journey through life, there is a constant unfolding of God's presence and revelation. We need to maintain joyful expectation, trusting that the fullness of God's plan is still to come. Light will come. For Simeon, it arrived in his old age; for Anna, it came while she was serving in the temple.

May we, too, remain patient, faithful, and expectant, knowing that God's promises will be fulfilled in His perfect time, uniquely for each of us.
