Put out into deep water

This weekend, for the Fifth Sunday in Ordinary Time, the Gospel is Jesus calling the first disciples – Peter and James and John, the sons of Zebedee. He had sat down in Peter's boat to teach the crowds. After he had finished speaking he told Peter to 'put out into deep water and pay out your nets for a catch.' Peter obeyed Jesus but he had said that they had worked all night and caught nothing. They caught so many fish that they had to call the other boat, and we are told, that both boats were at sinking point. Peter recognises that he is unworthy but instead of Jesus leaving, he asks Peter and James and John to follow him and become fishers of people. When they returned to the land, they left everything and followed Jesus.

Put out into the deep, Duc in Altum, has been a very significant phrase for me. It is the motto of Bishop Vincent and the Residential College I attended at the University of Tasmania used it as well. Going out into the deep can be scary, it can put us in 'danger' or at least out of our comfort zone. But if we think of swimming, it is necessary to go out into the deep, so that we can fully swim. If you try and swim in too shallow water, the swimming stroke does not work. You hit your hand into the sandy bottom.

When Peter sees the great catch of fish, he calls on Jesus to leave because he as a 'sinful man' was unworthy of such blessings. I believe each of us can recognise Peter's feeling at that moment. We are unworthy of God's graces and blessings. But we are challenged to recognise that the graces and blessings that God gives us are never for us alone but so that we strengthened by those graces can go out and serve, to minister to others, to be God's witnesses in the world. As Jesus describes the situation, we are graced so that we may become fishers of people. In what ways are we being challenged to go out into the deep? May God bless you, all those you love and all who love you, at this special time of year.
