

A call to serve the wider community

Today's readings on the Sixth Sunday in Ordinary Time invite us to reflect on the two realities that govern who we are as Christians: the earthly world we live in now and the heavenly world that awaits us. The Gospel of Luke makes these evident.

Notice in Luke's version of the Beatitudes he wants us to hear the sermon in this carefully staged context. Luke puts it in a graphical scene that helps us see the intention of his teaching. Luke gives us this picture: Jesus – Twelve disciples – the wider group of disciples – crowds from Judea, Jerusalem, Tyre, and Sidon. The layout Luke presents us grabs our attention and helps us to understand his message.

St Luke wants to make us aware that the instruction of Jesus teaches about who we are as individuals and how we must behave before the wider group we are called to live with. Beatitudes remind us to be aware of the two realities we are presented with. What we are now and what we do will have a consequence for the other world. The message is for us to be attentive to how we live our lives now. How do we live and help others so that we continue to make the Kingdom of God present in our lives and the lives of others?

Let us learn to accept who we are and what is our state of life? The significant question is how are we open to the grace of God and allow the grace of God to inspire us to be closer to him and others in our communities. Let us work together and support each other to live for the Kingdom of God.
