#### THE SEASON OF LENT: ASH WFDNFSDAY

The season of Lent begins on Ash Wednesday when the Church puts ashes on our foreheads and calls us to penitence. Penitence, above all else, means conversion. In this regard the passage of the gospel of Ash Wednesday is very significant. Jesus speaks about carrying out acts of penitence known to and practised by his contemporaries. At the same time, he criticises the purely external ways in which these acts of charity, fasting, and prayer are carried out. The purpose of these acts of penitence is a sincere turning of our lives to God. Therefore, the first and principle meaning of penitence is interior.

#### For a person's words flow out of what fills their heart.

This weekend, the Eighth Sunday in Ordinary Time, is the last Sunday in Ordinary time until June, as next Wednesday, the Lenten Season begins with Ash Wednesday and after celebrating Easter we have the Easter Season.

In the Gospel this weekend Jesus delivers remarks that challenged his listeners, challenges you and I to reflect on how honest we are? Honest with ourselves, with others and ultimately with God. Jesus talks about the blind leading the blind and why people are so quick to point out the splinter in another's eyes without first noticing the plank in their own?

For we are invited to reflect on the reality that the words of a person flow from what fills their heart. It can be uncomfortable to recognise limitations and shortcomings, but this honesty also enables you and I to be able to call on people that are talented in those areas where we are 'weak' or lack confidence to offer their talents and gifts in service.

It becomes important to recognise that no one is born evil. People do evil things because they are tempted and make bad decisions, which leads to more and more evil acts but no one is inherently rotten. From the Gospel, Jesus says: "A good man draws what is good from the store of goodness in his heart; a bad man draws what is bad from the store of badness." We can understand this from the perspective of how open someone is to God's grace. The good person is more open and therefore does good, the bad, is not so open and so tends to bad or selfish acts. The evil one's temptation is to arrogance and self sufficiency and so rather than looking to serve others and to encourage them, we can fall into the trap of being critical of others. We become keen to take the splinter out of another's eye without first taking out the plank from ours.

God loves everybody and pours blessings upon each of us. How open are we to receiving those blessings? No one is perfect, we all have limitations and shortcomings, but how comfortable are we to admit that?

May God bless you, all those you love and all who love you, at this special time of year.
